

A food truck operated by students that has completed 42 events and provided paid employment for 18 students.




Growing Outside the Box

A student-run media lab producing video and podcast content, including Stories With Papa hosted by Ed Kelce, which ranked 11th among US sports podcasts on Spotify.




Coming soon Tech Repair Shop
